TRINITY TERM PILGRIMAGES

On Wednesday evenings from Weeks 5 - 8 there will be a series of evening excursions (replacing the usual celebration of Night Prayer & Benediction.) We will visit the Charterhouse in London, Ascot Priory in Berkshire, the parish church of St Mary the Virgin, Freeland, and Binsey Chapel of St Margaret of Antioch. Please watch for further details.

ASCENSION DAY: THURSDAY, 13 MAY. High Mass at 12.15 p.m. Preacher: Father William Davage. *There will be no public Morning Prayer or early Mass.*

A MAY DEVOTION IN HONOUR OF OUR LADY will be celebrated jointly with the Parish of St Barnabas, Jericho, on Saturday, 15 May, beginning with Devotions and Sermon at St Barnabas' at 2.15 p.m. This will be followed by a Procession to Pusey House, Solemn Benediction; and drinks in the gardens.

THE CHOIR, SERVERS and READERS will be entertained to a buffet luncheon on Sunday, 23 May (Pentecost) after the High Mass.

CORPUS CHRISTI. This year, the principal celebration of the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ will be on Sunday, 6 June. High Mass, Procession of the Blessed Sacrament and Solemn Benediction at 11.00 a.m. On the evening of Wednesday, 2 June, we will visit Ascot Priory, where a Procession of the Blessed Sacrament will take place through the Priory grounds, followed by Benediction. On Thursday, 3 June, an additional Low Mass of Corpus Christi (Extraordinary Form) will be celebrated at Noon.

THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS: FRIDAY, 11 JUNE. High Mass at 6.00 p.m., followed by Drinks and Strawberries in the gardens. Preacher: Father Barry Orford. *There will be no public Morning Prayer or early Mass*
