

Pusey House Library Creative Arts Competition – Rules

1. Entries are welcome by email or by post. If entering by email, please send your work as an attachment to pusey.librarian@stx.ox.ac.uk, with a covering message confirming your name and contact details. If entering by post, please send your work to: Pusey House Librarian, Pusey House, St Giles, Oxford, OX1 3LZ. Please enclose a covering letter confirming your name and contact details, plus an SAE if you would like your work to be returned to you after consideration by the judges.
2. In the interests of fairness, all entries will be judged anonymously. Please only include your personal details in your covering letter/email. Don't put your name or any other identifying information on your work itself.
3. Your entry should be your own, previously unpublished work.
4. Poetry entries should be no longer than 40 lines; fiction entries should be no longer than 2000 words; art entries should fit comfortably on one A5 page.
5. There is no entry fee and no limit to the number of entries you may submit.
6. All submissions must be received by 31st October 2020. Late entries unfortunately cannot be included in the judging process.
7. Entries are welcome from people of all ages and all backgrounds, located anywhere in the world.
8. All written entries must be predominantly in English. Translations into English from other languages are welcome, but the translator must seek permission from the author or copyright-holder of the original piece. If a translation is chosen for inclusion in the anthology, Pusey House will need to receive written proof that permission from the original author or copyright-holder has been obtained.
9. Entrants will retain the copyright and all moral rights to their own work.
10. Each successful entrant will receive a free contributor copy of the anthology.
