Today, we continue that vital work of preaching the Gospel and the handing down of the Catholic Faith within the Church of England, through the daily and weekly offerings of worship and through the pastoral care of all who seek our help. We endeavour to build a community where thoughtful and robust faith is nourished by rich worship; so that those who find a home at Pusey House are formed and enlivened in Christ for service in the Church and in the world.

The Library is open to all, Monday–Friday from 9.30am–5.25pm, as a study space, and for referencing open-shelf books.
